

Tickets will be issued on receipt of a completed booking form, cheque and SAE. Where an SAE is not enclosed, tickets will be retained to be collected at the theatre on the night of the performance.

It is really easy to book online and, of course, so convenient. Whenever you decide you want to book tickets for a show—whatever the day and whatever the time—you can go ahead.

But—and there's always a but, isn't there? - it is also, sadly, easy to make mistakes.

By making your booking too quickly, it is easy to book on the wrong day—or even to book for the wrong show! So....a word to the wise...

CHECK, CHECK AND CHECK AGAIN at every stage of your booking that it exactly fits your requirements, as our booking agent does not make changes and refunds are only given if booking protection is take out with TicketSource, and the reason for cancellation is covered by their insurance.

Of course, if you are not entirely happy with the on-line process you can always use the postal option detailed above in the second bullet point.

A FINAL PLEA: If you have booked tickets and know that you, or one of your party, will not be able to attend, please let the Box Office know as soon as possible.

# About the Director, Anne Charbel

Anne has been performing in amateur theatrical productions since primary school.

During the pandemic, she started formally training with Identity School of Acting (IDSA). She appeared in June 2023 in An Intervention at BLT, prior to that as Regan in the Extraordinary Theatre Co.'s touring production of King Lear, then Ariel in The Tempest Re-Rigged (SISATA, 2023) and Cassion in Othello (60 Hour Shakespeare, 2023).



The *Memory of Water* is Anne's directorial debut and she looks forward with excitement to the audience's reaction to her strong cast's hilarious yet poignant rendition of this wonderful play.

# About the playwright, Shelagh Stephenson

Shelagh Stephenson was born in Tynemouth, Northumberland in 1955 and read drama at Manchester University.

She worked as an actress with The Royal Shakespeare Company and on television. She appeared in Coronation Street in 1981 as the minor character Sandra Webb. She also had parts in Rumpole's Return, Sapphire & Steel, The Gentle Touch, The Adventures of Sherlock Holmes, Boon, Paradise Postponed and Big Deal

She is the author of several original radio plays written for BBC Radio, including *Darling Peidi*, *The Anatomical Venus* and *Five Kinds of Silence* (1997), which won the Writer's Guild Award (Best Original Radio Play). Recent plays include *Life is a Dream* and *Nemesis*, broadcast in 2004 and 2005 respectively.

Her first stage play, *The Memory of Water* (1997), won the Sony Award for Best Original Drama in 1997 and the Laurence Olivier Award for Best Comedy in 2000.







#### SCENE ONE review of The GHOST TRAIN



13 December

On a cold winter's night after a long day at work, the thought of venturing out to Winton to see a play I'd never heard of was hard but I'm so glad I did! What a show!

The Ghost Train, written by Arnold Ridley and directed by Lindsay Jones, is set in a dysfunctional railway in the depths of Cornwall. It centres around a group of travellers who become stranded and must stay overnight in the haunted station when they are told the story of the 'Ghost train' that is said to pass through with terrible effects of those who see it. They regret their decision to stay after ghostly and not so ghostly apparitions materialise, until one of the passengers finally reveals the true reason behind the night's events.

The scenery used in this play is exceptional, it is perfect for the setting and the lighting effects, though simple, really send a shiver down your spine.

The costumes are brilliant and each tailored to suit every individual part; as a fellow actor I always feel so much more in character when I'm in a good costume!

John Billington as Mr Winthrop was perfectly posh and plays his character with real passion alongside his onstage (and offstage!) wife, Elsie, played by Tracey Billington-Beardsley. Miss Bourne, played by Gillian Linford, was a delight to watch and her comedy timing was brilliant. Every single person in this play gave their all but a special mention must go to Barry Gray as Teddie Deakin, his characterisation, facial expressions and body language absolutely shone in this performance, this part suited him perfectly.

The Ghost Train runs at Bournemouth Little Theatre until Saturday 16 December. Tickets are almost sold out, but if you manage to grab one of the few left, you won't be disappointed.
